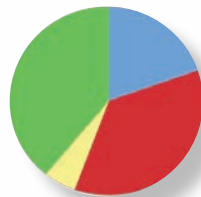

We are grateful to the Lord for a strong ministry year at JSM (July 1, 2005 – June 30, 2006). At the April 2005 meeting just before the end of our previous ministry year, the JSM Board asked the staff to focus attention and effort on increasing the number of our ministry supporters in the year ahead. It was good and timely counsel. Since the year 2001, our staff team had focused on creating international program strategies and budgets by partnering with the other four national Langham Partnership movements. Because we did not have the “bandwidth” to address developmental issues at the same time as these critical program issues, a small addition of one full-time and one part-time staff members enabled us to make significant improvements in our communications and outreach efforts.

INCREASE IN JSM SUPPORTERS AND ANNUAL INCOME.

Well, the extra effort we put into expanding our number of supporters has been blessed by the Lord! In the last year, we more than doubled the number of JSM supporters and, as a result, we had the greatest income total in our history – approximately \$2,750,000. Most of these new supporters connected to the ministry through our unique Langham Partners program, a group of monthly donors whose support provides books and training for pastors throughout the Majority World. The major communications and development efforts launched over the past year were part of our threefold effort to ensure that John Stott is able to fully engage in the future plans of this work throughout his later years. The three efforts have been: the hiring of key staff leaders, the expansion and enhancement of our three ministry programs, and the strengthening of our support base for the future. The hiring of Dr. Chris Wright as our International Director and Meritt Sawyer, Pieter Kwant and Jonathan Lamb as our International Program Directors for the Langham Scholars, Literature and Preaching Programs respectively accomplished the first effort. A substantial increase and improvements in the number of sponsored scholars, literature projects, and preaching seminars addressed the second goal. And now, the Langham Partners and other development efforts have accomplished our third goal. In recent meetings with John Stott, he said, "I thank God for His provision of the right people, program strategies, and resources to take this work beyond my lifetime." We praise God for these encouraging words from our founder and for the great conclusion of our 2005-06 ministry year.
